Reminder — The Masquerade will begin at 5:30p in Palm E&F. Tempe's fireworks will be visible from the pooldeck of the hotel, 9p-10p.

The pooldeck of the hotel will have restricted access on Saturday July 4. The hotel plans to allow Fiesta-Con badge holders access or non-members using a wristband arrangement. Wristbands are not required if you wear your convention badge in plain site unless you wish to purchase alcohol and then only if you look 30 or under per state law. Check with the hotel security at the pooldeck entrance on the 2nd floor for details.

Due to fire safety concerns the pooldeck will only accommodate 400 people at a time. The hotel plans to count the number of people entering the pooldeck area and will stop letting folks onto the deck when they reach 400. They will also count folks leaving the deck to allow additional folks onto the deck —

count in, count out. Closer to the fireworks they will probably reach capacity, so plan accordingly.

The hotel is opening up the cabana on the pooldeck to sell food and drink, alcohol and non-alcohol. Representatives of the hotel notified the convention one week ago of this arrangement. The convention arranged for badges to allow access in lieu of wristbands except for the under-30 alcohol concern. There may also be locals who enter the pooldeck in the morning and remain there throughout the day and into the night to watch the fireworks. Please check with the hotel pooldeck security early if you wish to understand this system better. Thanks for your understanding.

San Jose got a majority of the votes in the first round and is therefore elected to host Westercon 64.

The convention, which will be chaired by Glenn Glazer, announced Guests of Honor Patricia A. McKillip, Kaja & Phil Foglio, and Mike Willmoth. Westercon 64 will be July 1-4, 2011, at the Fairmont Hotel in San Jose, California. Memberships start at \$45 with discounts for those who pre-supported the bid and/or voted in site selection. If you both pre-supported SJ2011 and voted in site selection (or if you were a Friend of the SJ2011 Bid) you automatically get an attending membership and need to do nothing more. The convention web site, www.westercon64.org, should be online later this weekend.

Westercon 64 will begin selling memberships from the former San Jose in 2011 bid table outside the Dealers' Room at Noon on Saturday.
